

1. California Society of Printmakers at ACCI Gallery
2. My proposal is for an exhibition of CSP artists to show at the ACCI Gallery in Berkeley. Either in the summer of 2021, or more likely, a month to be determined in 2022. I am a member of the ACCI collective, and a future date can definitely be scheduled. I have talked to the Director and she is interested in having a CSP show.
3. Possibly the most interesting value of this exhibition could be the exchange between CSP and ACCI artists. Two arts groups will be present, and be able to see each other's work. Exhibition artwork is shown in the back area, while art / craft showing concurrently, is in the front and throughout the building. The ACCI Gallery is an established local, and professional venue where artists would be inviting, and interested in the focused work of an outside, but local group of printmakers. As well, CSP members would have the opportunity to show together locally, possibly for the first time since pre-covid times. In addition, there may be a few other CSP artists that are also ACCI members. The gallery maintains and exercises a large community list used in advertising these shows. I think the cross over is interesting and the show would be well attended for the scheduled month.

5. The exhibition area of the gallery consists of 6 walls which can potentially hold 30 pieces of artwork, hung in line across. I am told the last reception held over 150 people. I think 25 people should be able to participate. Each bringing one piece.
6. If this proposal is accepted I would like to invite artists based on work shown on the CSP artists page, unless the board were to think this unethical. I am also open to suggestions from the board, and the ACCI director.
7. The plan would be to first reserve the space. At this time ACCI is organizing this and next year's schedule. The next steps are to invite artists, create promotional materials and finally receive, and set up the space.
