
Mokuhanga Workshop at Equinox Press Studios

Mokuhanga (Japanese Woodblock Printing)
Saturday, March 30 and Saturday April 8, 10:00 am to 4:000 pm \$150

Frank Trueba, of Printmakers at the Tannery, is offering a mokuhanga workshops at Evelyn Klein's Equinox Studio. In order to provide individual and focused instruction, the two-day workshop is limited to 8 people.







Learn the basics of mokuhanga, the technique of Japanese woodblock printing. Mokuhanga uses water-based inks and no press—all printing is done by hand. This two-day workshop, includes an introduction to the history of mokuhanga. The workshop will focus on basic techniques (planning and transferring the design, carving the blocks, preparation of the paper and printing the image). Workshop price includes use of carving knives, bench hooks as well as Japanese paper, inks, nori, brushes and woodblocks (the only other expense would be purchase of a baren--the tool used for printing—I´II provide details to those interested).
