## It has the following equipment:

8x12 C&P (motor driven) with throw off. 2 sets of Gelatin rollers (need repair), morgan trucks, 5 chases.

Hoe Handpress (#4349) 13x18 in platen, belt driven with tympan and frisket. In excellent condition.

Book binders press 12x16 platen

3 cabinets of type. Various faces in families, most drawers seemed about half full.

1 cabinet 3/4 type cases. All drawers are filled with rule, cuts, wood type sorts, metal sorts.
