Karen Benioff Friedman studied drawing and printmaking at college in Massachusetts. Taking a gap year in Jerusalem led her to a profound connection to her Jewish roots and heritage. After her father died, she dug deeper into art, a passion they had shared, to feel closer to his memory and to honor his life. As she was delving further into art, she was also playing a prominent role in the local Chevra Kadisha (Jewish burial society), leading her to a life goal of portraying the work in its contemporary form.

Karen spent five years at the Golden Gate Atelier in Oakland. Earlier she earned a BA in Fine Art from Amherst College and attended the School of The Museum of Fine Arts in Boston.
